

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the writer describes about conclusion and suggestions for the reader to more understand about the research.

A. Conclusion

The following is the conclusion that the writer would like to reach after conducting a study and data analysis of the utterance that contains a perlocutionary act.

1. The analysis found that perlocutionary acts can not stand alone without locutionary and illocutionary acts. The writer analyzes the utterance by starting the first step by analyzing the act of locution to find out the statement uttered by the speaker. After knowing the statement of the speaker, the writer analyzes the intention of the statement and the writer can categorize the intention of the statement into the types of illocutionary acts that were proposed by Yule and Searle. The illocutionary action can produce an effect or response from the listener when the listener listens to the utterance of the speaker or what we know as perlocutionary act. The writer analyzes the perlocutionary act after knowing the meaning of the utterance and categorizes the response into the types of perlocution theorized by Leech.
2. According to the research, the writer found 27 data containing perlocutionary actions in the movie Beauty and The Beast. They are:

“Intended” contributed 81,5% (the highest proportion) with 22 data and “Unintended” type contributed 18,5% with 5 data (the lowest percentage).
