### **CHAPTER V**

#### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter provides the conclusion to the research question, that was taken from the data analysis conducted in the previous chapter. The writer also provides a suggestion to the other researcher and reader that will be explained below.

## A. Conclusion

Based on the data analysis, the writer came up with several conclusions regarding the implementation of the hero's journey in The Maze Runner Novel trilogy.

- 1. Thomas in The Maze Runner trilogy novels experiences a hero's journey in chronological order based on the theory that was proposed by Vogler. The writer found 34 pieces of data that showed Thomas's journey of his character development from being a nobody to a hero. The data analysis showed that Thomas passed all the twelve stages from the beginning until the end. The hero's journey stages that Thomas has passed through are, the ordinary world, call to adventure, refusal of the call, meeting with the mentor, crossing the first threshold, test, allies, and enemies, approach to the inmost cave, the ordeal, the reward, the road back, the resurrection, and return with elixir.
- 2. Thomas's portrayed three out of five types of hero that was proposed by Vogler theory. They are willing and unwilling hero, the group-oriented hero, and catalyst hero. In Thomas journey, the types of hero had a different impacts. Thomas did not portrayed the anti-hero and loner hero type, as he the type who always did

his mission with his friends beside him and he types of hero who defeating the evils and not the one who become evil. Whereas among the there types he more dominant in the willing and unwilling types as he was always in situations that made him willingly help others even to the point of being willing to sacrifice himself, and Thomas also always showed the type of unwillingly hero when he first encountered danger or when he did not succeed in saving his friends.

This writer has several suggestion to provide as the analysis has been concluded. The suggestion provided is expected to be useful for the readers and other researchers.
