CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

Based on the findings, the writer concludes that simile is a style of language that expresses comparisons between different things to highlight their similarities or contrasts, often adding vividness or clarity to the description. And Symbols, as a style of language, represent abstract ideas or concepts through concrete objects, images, or signs, allowing for deeper layers of meaning and interpretation within a text. As a result, from 6 songs, the writer found 27 data. more detail, following:

- 1. The writer discovered 2 of the 2 types of simile and symbol in Taylor Swift song lyrics. They are as follows: 4 Literal simile, 4 Non Literal simile, 12 Conventional Symbol, and 7 personal Symbol. Based on the data analysis and discussion, conventional symbol has the highest percentage 44% Then, it is followed by personal symbol with the percentage 26%. And then non literal simile with the percentage 15%, literal simile has the lowest percentage 15%.
- 2. The analysis of meaning emphasizes the importance of studying and comprehending the meaning of figurative language. Figurative language helps readers understand deeper or more abstract concepts by drawing comparison or using symbol. For example, a simile compares one thing to another using "like or as", while a symbol represents an idea or concepts beyond its literal meaning. By examining these elements, readers gain insight into how it enhance and shape the meaning within a literary work.

B. Suggestions

1. For the writer

For the writer in this research there are still many weaknesses that the writers make both in theory and analysis, however, the writer hopes that this research can help the readers to understand more about figurative language such as similes and symbols and the meaning is simile and symbol that is frequently appeared in the lyrics of the song

2. For the reader

For the reader in analyzing the types of simile and symbol, the writer must read a lot of books about simile also symbol so that knowledge about simile and symbol is more in depth. The writer advises that readers have more references about figurative language, mainly in song lyric and particularly types of simile and symbol so that this research can be carried out perfectly.

3. For the students

for the students who have high interests about literature, especially in studying figurative language such as simile and symbol. this finding can be helpful to give simple explanations and examples of simile, and symbol as figure of speech. Therefore, the students can distinguish whether it is simile, and symbol in the test.
