CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

Based on the research has been done about the social deixis in Tintin Comics: *The King Ottokar's Sceptre* which published by Belgium, written by Hergé in 1958. The researcher reaches the conclusion, as follows's:

- There are 30 sentences to contain the social deixis in Tintin Comic: The King Ottokar's Sceptre.
- 2. There are two kinds of social deixis form, namely absolute and relation. There are 19 lexicals to contain absolute in social deixis in which it involves the lexicals sire, professor, colonel, captain, yung foreigner and king. And in other side, there are 11 lexicals to contain relation in social deixis, namely brother, boy, gentlemen, and sir.
- 3. In relation of social deixis form, there are 3 characters of relation of social deixis, namely referent honorific, addressee honorific and formality level. In referent honorific, there are 2 lexicals. In addressee honorific, there are 3 lexicals. And the last, in formality level, there are 6 lexicals.
- 4. Out of 30 sentences which contain the social deixis, there are 10 kinds of social deixis, viz sir, sire, king, professor, captain, colonel, young foreigner, gentlemen, brother and boy

- 5. From 5 kind of language's function, there are only 4 kinds of language's function in Tintin comics: *The King Ottokar's Sceptre*, viz Informative function, Expressive function, Directive function and Phatic function.
- 6. After analyzed the result, there is 24% lexical "sir" which it located in 2 sentences of informative function, 4 sentences of directive function and 1 sentences of phatic function.
- 7. From the research also found that there is 20% lexical "sire" which it located in 4 sentences of informative function, 1 sentences of directive function and 1 sentences of phatic function.
- 8. There is also found 13% lexical "king" which located in 3 sentences of informative function and 1 sentences of expressive function.
- 9. The researcher also found there is 10% in lexical "captain" and "professor" each other. In the lexical "professor", there are 1 sentences of expressive function, 2 sentences of directive function. In the lexical "captain", there are in 3 sentences of informative function.
- 10. There is 7% in the phrase "young foreigner" and "boy" in the lexical "young foreigner" which involves 1 sentences of informative function and 1 sentence of directive function, as well as in the lexical "boy" there is in 1 sentence of informative function and 1 sentence of directive function.
- 11. The last, there are 3% in the lexical "gentlemen, brother and colonel" which the lexical "gentlemen" is in 1 sentence of phatic function, the lexical "brother" is in 1 sentence of informative function and the lexical "colonel" is in 1 sentence of directive function.

- 12. From the analysis result, the lexical "sir" is more dominant in Tintin comics: *The King Ottokar's Sceptre* amounting 24%.
- 13. It is known that the lexical "gentlemen, brother and colonel" is the minority social deixis found with 3% of each other.

B. Suggestion

Based on result of analysis conclusion that has been spelt out about the social deixis in Tintin comic: *The King Ottokar's Sceptre*, the researcher gives some suggestions are as follows:

1. For readers,

The researcher hopes that this research will add and provide the information and knowledge about the linguistics world, especially about pragmatics matter in the sub of deixis about social deixis.

2. For beginner linguistic,

This research is expected to add the knowledge and information that needed by students about linguistics. This is very essential in pragmatics as it is as a branch of knowledge in linguistics, specifically in the deixis that discusses about social deixis.

3. For next researcher,

In this research, the researcher pretends too many weaknesses because of limited experience research time. Nevertheless, the researcher hopes that this research will provide many information about the social deixis and help the next researcher to developed the information more deeply.
