

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

#### A. Conclusion

After having analyzed 20 data in the previous chapter, it can be concluded that there are so many grammatical errors that occur in some tweets made by influencer that @zelazele Twitter account follows. The writer just focused on finding the types of part of speech and grammatical errors that occur in data taken from English tweets made by personal accounts with minimum 100 followers count on @zelazele following list Twitter account. From the previous thoughts, it can be concluded as follows:

1. From 20 data that has been analyzed, the writer found some of part of speech concerning grammatical error which occur in the tweets posted by following list on @zelazele Twitter account. The types of part of speech that occur in the data are noun, pronoun, verb, adverb, preposition, adjective, and conjunction.
2. From 20 data that has been analyzed in chapter IV, the writer found that 1 datum might contain some grammatical errors. From 50 frequencies of grammatical error found in 20 data taken found some the types of grammatical error, they are comma splice, missing comma in compund sentence, missing word, sentence fragment, spelling, subject-verb agreement, unnecessary comma, unnecessary

or missing apostrophe, unnecessary or missing capitalization, unnecessary or missing hyphen, and wrong word. The common grammatical error that occur in the data taken is wrong word with 11 frequencies of error (22%).

## **B. Suggestion**

After analyzing and giving conclusion about grammatical error in English tweet made by personal accounts with minimum 100 followers count on @zelazele following list Twitter account, the writer would like to draw suggestions of this research, so that it can be helpful for everyone.

### 1. For the reader

After knowing the types of grammatical errors that occur in this research, the writer suggests the readers to do the double-check on their writings, especially in social media, to avoid the possibility of making some grammatical error.

### 2. For the next researcher

After completing this research, the writer suggests the next researcherto analyze the grammatical errors on any other social media which had the writing on it i.e Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn, etc.

### 3. For the campus

During the research, the writer might need several references to support the writing. The writerfelt that the lack of references from
