CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of the Study

The writer will teach students using SQ4R method and students are asked to understand the effects after using this SQ4R technique. The students asked to explore again how this technique is used in reading. In this SQ4R technique, the writer will explain what reading is.

According to Carolyn (2002, p. 32) one of strategis that is used to help students problem in reading comprehension of narrative text was SQ4R technique. SQ4R is an acronym for Survey Question Read Recite Reflect Review. SQ4R is one strategy designed to help in using their textbooks effectively. It can be concluded that SQ4R is the effective technique to get the purpose of reading to improve the students' comprehension. The students can understand the meaning and comprehend the reading text.

SQ4R provides a systematic way of comprehending and studying text. It means that by using SQ4R, students can comprehend and study the text by using systematic way which are; previewing text to develop predictions and setting a purpose for reading by generating questions about the topic, reading actively, searching for answers to the questions they have generated, summarizing information that they get, and evaluating their comprehension through review. By doing so, it is expected that students' independency and effort in reading English text can be increased, and their achievement can be developed.

Based on experience and observation, SQ4R reading strategy never been taught in reading class. It is worth to be implemented on student because its has some advantages. One of the critical parts is reflecting where the students are able to think critically about what they have learned and have yet to learn related the topic. This type of critical thingking is necessary if students want to become mature readers.

Reflecting on what has been read also helps students retain understanding for longer periods time. The more students reflect on the text the longet they will remember it and the more likely they will be able use the knowledge they have trained.

Reading techniques and the time when to use them are indeed important, especially under exam conditions when time constraints come into play and decisions need to be made depending on time availability and the importance of the task at hand.

Reading is the complex cognitive process of decoding symbols to derive meaning, it is a form of language processing, Reading is a means for language acquisition, communication, sharing information and ideas. The educational development today cannot be seperated from the development of science and techonology. Reading is one of the main aspects of English skills taught in Indonesian schools. Reading plays an important role in all schools. Without adequate reading skills, the students can struggle in many subjects areas. By reading, the students may get more knowledge as they are able to comprehend and construct the meaning of the text. The education demand always move along with global technological development. In relation to education, teaching and learning in the class was demanded to be innotative and creative. In the case of English lesson, reading skills are very low mastered by the students today. No doubt that todays technology advances, but it is still lacking in effect of

using SQ4R (Survey, Question, Read, Recite, Reflect and Review) technique towards students reading comprehension.

The highest level on reading is reading comprehension. It represents readers ability to integrate the information in the text. According to Al-Khateeb (2010, p. 72) "Reading comprehension is a dynamic interactive process between the readers and the reading materials". It means that the readers have to use their ability to acquire the information provided in the text. Students are one of classroom components that take an important part in reaching learning process. It means that reading methods can assist their comprehension and identify relevant and non-relevant information. In reading, there are many reading methods such as speed reading, critical reading, proof reading to facilitate comprehension and to make their reading more effective.

Reading is one the four skills which need to be learned besides listening, speaking, and writing. Reading has the considerable role in the language teaching to strengthen the skills which are acquired by students in listening, speaking and writing (Maxom, p. 139). Reading skills affect the others skills in learning process. Besides, the students have to be able to achieve reading competencies as urged by the national curiculum.

In some schools setting, the students get some information from textbooks which are written in English. These textbooks contain a lot of information related to the subjects the learnes learned. In order to access this information, they need sufficient knowledge of English. Especially, they should have the skills of reading because it is written in the textbooks so that they could comprehend it well. That is why the reading skills are important to be mastered.

C. Research Hypothesis

Ho: There is significant effectiveness of using SQ4R (Survey, Question, Read, Recite, Review and Reflect) strategy towards students reading comprehension for the first semester of eight grade at SMPN 11 Tambun-Selatan.

Ha: There is no significant effectiveness of using SQ4R (Survey, Question, Read, Recite, Review and Reflect) strategy towards students reading comprehension for the first semester of eight grade at SMPN 11 Tambun-Selatan.

D. The Objective and Significance of the Research

1. Objective of the Research

The objective of the research is to know whether there is a significant effect using survey, question, read, review and reflect

strategy towards student's reading comprehension of the first semester of the eight grade SMPN 11 Tambun Selatan of academic year of 2020/2021.

2. Significance of the Research

a. Theoretically

Theoritically, the result of the research was expected to support the theory which explained in the next chapter about the effect of SQ4R strategy towards student's reading comprehension at the first semester of the eight grade students of junior high school.

b. Pratically

- 2. For the teachers, the teachers are expected to apply strategy, especially at the eight grade of SMPN 11 Tambun- Selatan that SQ4R strategy was more effective in teaching reading comprehension.

E. Method of the Research

In line with the research problem, the writer uses pre-experimental research with one group pre-test and post-test in the research. There is

attribute or characteristic that you assess for participants in an

A post-test is a measure on some attribute or characteristic that is

assessed for participants in an experiment after treatment. If the post-test

score higher than the pre-test, this indicates that there is an influence between speaking class in production department with their skill in communication.
