## **CHAPTER V**

## **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

## A. CONCLUSION

The research has been particularly concerned at the presupposition pragmatically in "*The Girl Who Fell*" novel by S.M. Parker. To sum up this chapter, the writer focused from the context in a conversation contained in every part of the conversation between utterance of presupposition in "*The Girl Who Fell*" novel by S.M. Parker. After analyzed the data of this study, the writer describe some conclusion as follows:

a. In the theory of Yule's there are six presupposition that are existential presupposition, factive presupposition, lexical presupposition, structural presupposition, non-factive presupposition and counter-factual presupposition.

- b. In the branch of linguistics known as pragmatic, a presupposition is an implicit assumption about the world or background belief relating to an utterance whose truth is taken for granted in discourse.
- c. In *The Girl Who Fell* novel the writer found 32 utterances were found there are 6 utterances of existential presupposition, 2 utterances of factive presupposition, 10 utterances of lexical presupposition, 5 utterances of structural presupposition, 1 utterances of non-factive presupposition, 8 utterances of counterfactual presupposition. From the result of the data, it can be

concluded that the most dominant in *The Girl Who Fell* is lexical presupposition with 10 utterances from 32 totals. It can be understood because of the background of this novel is a story of romance who the main character Zephyr and another flashback what they doing before. Based on situation above, this is normal if the writer found many lexical presupposition in the novel.

## A. SUGGESTION

Based on the conclusion above, the writer would like to give some suggestion that maybe useful in the future. To whom the writer concerns are:

1. For the readers

The writer finding of this research hopes can be one of the references to be considered in the teaching and learning process. It is suggested to they who study language or having linguistics the concentration to understand and study more about pragmatics especially in presupposition because presupposition deals with implied meaning that cannot be understood as easily as literal meaning.

2. English Department Students

The writer hope this research could be one of references in studying presupposition especially to give more understanding about presupposition as one of the part pragmatics study in linguistic field. It is still limited in the explanation of types of presupposition. The

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Yule's theory to conduct this research. There are still abundant experts who concern in studying pragmatics, especially presupposition. Therefore, the writer expects that other writer will conduct a further study focusing on the presupposition.
