CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

After analyzing all of the data, it has been concluded that there are indirect speech act which exist in the *Aladdin* movie. The classification is form by the theory of Brinton and Yule. The writer draws some conclusion as follows:

- 1. From data collected, the writer found 25 indirect speech acts of utterances that produce on the dialogues that used in the *Aladdin* movie. The writer found there are 5 type of indirect speech act, which is indirect speech act as request, assert, warn, advice and thank.
- 2. To understanding indirect speech act or other implicit meaning from the speaker's utterances, the first way is to describe and analyzing the context of the situation such as time, place and who is the addresser.
- 3. The most dominant type of indirect speech act which used in the Aladdin movie is as a request. The use of indirect request or indirect directive is for asking someone to do something in a more polite way.
- 4. Indirect speech acts are more difficult to understand than direct speech acts, because to understand it, we must really pay attention to the

circumstances and situations around so that the indirect speech act can be successful and the hearer will know the speaker's intention.
