

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter conveys two different sections that are conclusions and suggestion. In conclusions, some points are concluded from the results based on the objectives of this research. In suggestions, some suggestions are given to some parties related to the results.

A. Conclusions

Based on the findings and discussions, some conclusions can be formulated as follows:

1. Regarding the objective of this research, which is identifying the types and function of the taboo words in *Deadpool* movie 2016, seven from nine types of taboo words are found which are cursing, profanity, obscenity, vulgarity, epithets, scatology, and the last insult and slur. Meanwhile, 2 of another types that are not found blasphemy and slang. The highest frequency of the types of taboo words is obscenity with appears 14 times out of 34 total findings. The lowest frequency is obtained by cursing and profanity with only 1 datum.
2. The second objectives of this research describes the functions of taboo words in *Deadpool* movie 2016. There are five functions of taboo words that appear in this movie. They are joking, surprise, sarcasm, anger and frustration, and the last descriptive evaluative. The highest frequency with 44% and appear 15 times is anger and frustration. Joking becomes the lowest with the percentage 6% and appears only 2 times.

B. Suggestions

Based on the results of the research which have been obtained, some suggestions are stated for further research. This suggestions are presented as follows:

1. To student of English language and other researchers
 - a. Student and researcher should understand the kinds of methodology research first.
 - b. The student and researcher should understand about the different between qualitative and quantitative researches.
 - c. Student and researcher are automatically will understand what inductive and deductive mean.
 - d. The use of taboo word among the people is an interesting topic to be analyzed. The researcher suggested to the next researcher to develop this research because this topic is still considered taboo to be analyzed among linguists.
2. To the readers
 - a. The readers should understand about sociolinguistic.
 - b. The readers should understand about language variations elements.
 - c. The readers should understand about the taboo words and its smallest main data, words and phrases.
 - d. Through the results of this study, the researcher hopes to read this research in order to avoid the use of taboo words in everyday life and understand the meaning of them. There are still many words that are more

appropriate to use when you are feeling emotional because it does not always mean that the speaker want to hurt other people's feelings through the use of taboo words.

3. To the Literature Department and the Campus

- a. Lecture should know and understand about the student's research as reference and inform about the research to the new student.
- b. The researcher expects that this paper can be useful for students and readers in terms of analyzing works of sociolinguistic about the types and functions of taboo words.
