

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

Based on the findings the writer concludes that hyperbole is a style of language that expresses a statement with exaggeration, and sometimes it doesn't make sense, whose meaning is not to be taken literally. It is crucial part of figurative language it is closely related to utterance or expression in the song lyrics. As a result, from 7 songs, the writer found 30 data. More detail, following:

1. The writer finds five forms of hyperbole from seven forms in the song lyrics by One Direction, they are single word hyperbole, phrasal hyperbole, clausal hyperbole, repetition hyperbole, and comparison hyperbole. Based on all findings and analysis, each form has its own meaning in the song lyrics.

2. The most common form of hyperbole found in song lyrics is the single-word form, then the second most common is the clausal form, after that there is the phrasal form and the least found is the form of repetition and comparison.

Based on all findings from the hyperbole form have non-literal meanings because each data in the song lyrics has an implied meaning or more than one meaning behind the literal meaning and is also not meant to be interpreted literally.

In this research, the writer found advantages and disadvantages in analyzing this research. The advantage is that the writer can understand the definition and types of figurative language, especially hyperbole forms in song

lyrics. Meanwhile the disadvantage is that the writer finds it difficult to find sources about hyperbole in English. So, in analyzing this research the author spent quite a long time.

B. Suggestion

1. For the Writer

For the writer in this research there are still many shortcomings that the writer makes both in theory and analysis. However, the writer hopes that this research can help the readers to understand more about figurative language, especially hyperbole. To be able to determine the forms of hyperbole, we must first know the branch of science from semantics, figurative language, and then hyperbole.

2. For the Reader

For the reader in analyzing the forms of hyperbole, the reader must read a lot of books about hyperbole so that knowledge about hyperbole is more in-depth. The writer suggests that readers have more references about figurative language, especially the type of hyperbole so that this research can be carried out perfectly.
