CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of the Research

Preposition is one of the parts of speech. A preposition is also a word combined with a noun or pronoun, forming a phrase that explains the verb, noun, or adjective. Prepositions consist of various functions, including prepositions of time, place, movement, manner, purpose, and quantity/measure.

Prepositions of time are prepositions used to indicate time. A preposition of place is an English preposition that is used to denote a place or position. Prepositions of movement are prepositions used to indicate movement. Preposition of manner is an English preposition that shows the relationship "way" between the object and other words in a sentence. Prepositions of purpose are prepositions that show the "purpose" relationship between the object and other words in a sentence. A preposition of quantity is an English preposition that indicates the "quantity" or "size" relationship between the object and the other words in a sentence.

In the comic Gotham City Sirens series 7 (February 2010), Harley visits her family during the holiday season. They are described as having psychiatric disorders. The reason Harley became that psychiatrist was to understand her own family.

It is said that Harleen Quinzel used to be a psychiatrist at the Arkham Asylum mental hospital and was assigned to care for the Joker. She ends up falling in love with the Joker and becomes her lover and accomplice after the Joker turns her mind around with a series of lies. Harleen Quinzel followed suit in the look and nature of an evil clown and adopted the name Harley Quinn which was derived from the character in Commedia Dell'arte. The Joker is called 'Mr J' and 'Puddin', a term of affection used in almost every adaptation where these two characters appear. Sometime after Enchantress's defeat, the Joker and Harley Quinn have returned to Gotham.

In the midst of their violent relationship, the Joker broke off his relationship with Harley and kicked her out of his home. Finally, Harley was brought by an old man named Doc who owned a Chinese restaurant in town. After his mind recovers, Harley goes partying and spends the night at a club owned by Roman Sionis, a sadistic gangster who has a cruel tendency to disguise himself as the owner of a cheerful nightclub. Meanwhile, Harley meets Dinah Lance, a burlesque singer who works with Roman. Harley gets drunk and makes a scene at the club, so he injures Roman's driver and causes Roman's accomplice to drag Harley, but Dinah saves him from Roman's henchmen before the violence occurs. Roman, who was amazed by Dinah's dexterity, appointed him as his new driver.

Dinah drives Harley to Harley's house and Harley decides to change her life in many ways, including cutting her hair and adopting a hyena from an exotic pet shop (which she named after Bruce Wayne). Harley also destroyed Ace Chemicals, where he promised the Joker before becoming Harley Quinn. Meanwhile, Renee Montoya, a police detective at the Gotham City Police Department (GCPD), arrives at Ace Chemicals and ensures Harley will be easily arrested and detained because the Joker and Harley relationship has broken up. At the same time, Cassandra Cain, an orphan who works with Roman as a thief, steals a diamond which has information that is very important to Sionis.

Roman sends Dinah and his main accomplice, a mad serial killer named Victor Zsasz, to get the diamond back. However, Cassandra Kain multiplies herself and evades Roman to sell diamonds and get more money. Cass is caught and swallows the diamond in despair. The next day, Harley is intercepted by Renee while she is eating wind in Gotham. Harley escapes from the scene before being ambushed by several of Roman's henchmen. Harley killed the accomplice before finally being caught back by another accomplice who arrived there. Victor and Dinah tell Roman about Cassandra's status. It appears that Roman likes to wear black masks - which are works of art - while torturing people as a tactic of intimidation.

Dinah and Victor also tell him that they captured Harley, and as a result, they decide not to anticipate retaliation from the Joker, citing Harley's destruction of Ace Chemicals as evidence of the two being separated. Dinah sends a message to Montoya about Cassandra's situation, who reveals that he is a bully in the Roman syndicate. Through the fourth wall, Harley reveals to the audience that they know more about the events in the film. Harley then hears Roman talking about the diamond, then he offers the diamond to take it from Cassandra if he saves it. Roman agrees and shares his ration with Harley one day. Roman promises a gift to anyone who wants Cassandra's head to make her happier.

Harley disguises herself and breaks into GCPD to take Cassandra away to an abandoned antique shop to get the diamonds out of Cassandra and return them to Roman. However, the two of them are ambushed by armed thugs who want a gift from Roman. Harley slaughtered them after not trying to inhale cocaine from a sack that was perforated from being shot repeatedly. The prize also attracted the interest of Helena Bertinelli, the street fighter known as the "crossbow killer". Helena targets mobsters in the hope of avenging her murdered family and also plans to use Cass with the intent to lure Roman out. Meanwhile, Dinah discovers that she has the metahuman ability to scream at a supersonic level. Dinah texts Montoya about the bounty on Cass, but the text is discovered by Zsasz, who informs Roman. Roman flies into a rage, as he strongly dislikes a subordinate not following orders, and he scratches and damages his face in the process.

Harley and Cass decide to hide out at Harley's apartment. However, the apartment is bombed by people looking for Cass and it is revealed that Doc sold Harley out to Roman. Harley calls Roman and agrees to turn Cass over in exchange for protection from the bounty as a result of the lack of trust. Roman sends and Dinah to retrieve Cass. Harley while showing that Roman didn't honor their deal, and Dinah tries to free Cass. However, having already known about Dinah's treachery, attacks her but is unexpectedly killed by Helena, who arrives at the amusement park. The women are all placed under arrest by Montoya, who Dinah had texted with regard to the situation. Harley manages to convince the women to work together to fight off Roman, even though the others were initially reluctant.

The women use Harley's old gear and weapons to attack arriving hordes of Roman's goons, eventually emerging victorious. Cass is captured by Roman, and Harley pursues them to a nearby pier. Once Harley catches up with them, Cassandra puts a grenade in Roman's suit, killing him. In the aftermath of destroying Roman's empire, Montoya, Dinah and Helena start the Birds of Prey with the money from the accounts of the diamond while Harley and Cassandra pawn it and start their own company together.
