## **CHAPTER V**

## **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

## A. Conclusion

After analyzing the previous chapter, about the effects of capitalism impact the society in *The Young Karl Marx* film as the object data analysis, it has been concluded some conclusions based on data study.

- The impact of capitalism in this film affects 4 fields of society there are: class creation of society as the most classifications that found in the film with percentage 57 %, women exploitations have 17 %, economy fields have 13 % and politics fields also have same percentage 13 %.
- 2. In this film, capitalism already in the social environment of society, where the capitalism continues to develop continuously to gain profits in the market through capital owners who use community labor. The impacts of capitalism felt by 4 fields of society are found in this film. First, Class creations, capitalism can proceed because there are owners of capital and there are people who become labor for the benefit of the market, thus causing the emergence of the bourgeois class and the proletarian class. The formation of this class occurs because of injustice and inequality in the welfare of life. The bourgeoisie, as the owners of capital, has a luxurious life, while the proletarian class, which is the labor force, lives in poverty. Second, Women exploitations, capitalism causes women to have a life full of misery, at low wages, working as long as possible, so that women are

considered not to have any power to fight. Then, Economy Fields, the impact of capitalism on the economy of society is a money become benchmark for human values. Last, Politics Fields, regulations made by the government only benefit personal interests and the highest economic owner without thinking about the lives of other people.

## **B.** Suggestion

Based on the analysis of capitalism impact the society in The Young Karl Marx film, the writer provides several suggestions that will be useful for the students and other researchers who are interested in literature study, especially sociology of literature.

- 1. To students, especially the English Department students who are interested in literature study. They are expected to explore the impact of capitalism in society. There are still many fields that are feeling the impact of capitalism such as the middle class, exploited children, commodities in the market and technological developments. Further, they are also expected to employ other media as the research, such as novels and television series.
