CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

After analyzing those data, it has been conclude that there are fricative phonemes in short story *Runaway* by Alice Munro. There are eight fricative phoneme, f', and f'. The voiced and voiceless. The voiceless fricatives are f', f', f', f', and f'. The voiced fricatives are f', f'

- 1. Kinds of fricative phonemes that are read by fourth semester students in "Runaway" short story by Alice Munro are 5 are /f/ and /v/ (labiodental fricative), /θ/ and /ð/ (dental fricative), /s/ and /z/ (alveolar fricative), /ʃ/ (alveopalatal fricative), and /h/ (glottal fricative). The writer does not find fricative /ʒ/ (alveopalatal fricative) in the data.
- 2. There are many mistakes of pronounce that found by the fourth semester students there are:
 - a. in Nur Akmalia Supriyanto, the writer find in the word **the** fricative /ð/ become /d/, in the word **she** fricative /ʃ/ become /s/, in the word **thought** fricative /θ/ become /t/, in the word **Mrs** fricative /z/ become /s/, there is missing /z/ and also wrong spelling from Mrs into mis and mister and the las in the word **drive** fricative /v/ become /f/.

- b. In Rio Wibowo, in the word **was** fricative /z/ become /s/, in the word **wave** fricative /v/ become /f/ and in the word **of** fricative /v/ become /f/.
- c. In Rico Effendi, in the word of fricative /v/ become /f/ and in the word with fricative /θ/ and /ð/ become /t/.
- d. In Andiva Ardhana, in the word other fricative /ð/ become /d/, in the word telephone fricative /f/ become /p/, in the word those fricative /ð/ become /d/ and /z/ become /s/, in the word every fricative /v/ become /f/, in the word thick fricative /θ/ become /t/ and in the word shirt fricative /ʃ/ become /s/.
