CHAPTER I

This movie tells a story of a famous painter named Einar Wegener who decided to change his identity into a woman because he felt comfortable and also feel like in his body, he is actually a woman when he put his wife dresses on, heels, even wigs. His wife, Gerda Wegener, is also a painter but not as famous as her husband. Until one day, Gerda hired a model for his painting who was a friend of her named Ulla. But she was too late to come so she decided to use her husband as a medium for her painting by wearing her husband the female attributes that should be worn by the model. Since then, Einar is comfortable being a woman and decides to become a complete woman by performing a surgery and changing her identity to Lili Elbe.

The reason why the writer chose this as an object is because the movie was interesting to analyze for this research. There are few reasons. First, *The Danish Girl* is a movie based on true story which the main character really did a genital surgery and the first transsexual case in the world that happened and became hyped all over the world. Second, this movie is telling about the situation and also portrays 1920s in Denmark which we can see the point of view by its people in there at that year such as the culture, the people, and the situation that happened.
