

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGESSTION

A. Conclusion

In this chapter, the writer finally makes conclusion of the morphological based on the neutral and non-neutral suffixes in the Two by Two Novel by Nicholas sparks. The writer only found 3 kinds of neutral suffixes such as –ly, -less and -ness and 4 kinds of non-neutral suffixes such as –ion, -ic, -th and -ist in this novel. The most kinds of suffixes that writer found is neutral suffix –ly.

In this research, the writer found that the neutral suffixes –ly changed the meaning and word class from adjective to adverb. Neutral suffixes –less changed the meaning and word class to adjective. Neutral suffixes –ness changed the meaning and word class to noun. All of the neutral suffixes do not change the sounds and stress to the bases which they are attached.

Eventually, the writer also found that all of the non-neutral suffixes –ion changed the meaning and word class to noun. Non-neutral suffixes –ic changed the meaning and word class to adjective. Non-neutral –th changed the meaning and word class to noun. Non-neutral suffixes -ist changed the meaning and word class to noun. All of the non-neutral suffixes changed the sounds and stress to the bases which they are attached. The writer found more neutral suffixes than non-neutral suffixes in those novel.

B. Suggestion

For the Student, the writer encourages students taking formal education of English to learn about morphology as well as learning other field about linguistics. It is expected that this paper will be one of references for them in understanding about morphology which contains neutral and non-neutral suffixes.

For the Colleges, the writer expects this paper will be useful and can add references books in STBA JIA library. In order to make students easier doing their research, the writer suggested the college to provide more books of linguistic especially about morphology. The writer hopes that for the students who are doing the research, they must not waste their time to find references by visiting other universities also they can find the reference in STBA JIA library.

For the lecturers, the writer expects this paper can be helpful to share the students some examples about the difference between neutral and non-neutral suffixes based on their morphological changes. The writer hopes that the lecturer can increase more exercise to expand student skill in this theory.
