

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

After analyzing reverses in *Perfume: The Story of Murderer* novel as a research topic, it has been concluded some conclusions based on the data study:

1. There are some reverses pair in the novel. The most reverses types found in the novel is reverse literal with percentage 50 %, while reverse motion has 35% and the last is reverse antonym has 15 %.
2. Classifying the type of reverses correctly needed knowledge about the characteristic each type of reverses because only those pairs that are included in the reverses that only have the same movement in the opposite direction.
3. The reverses pair is found to describe the movement situation in the opposite direction, such as straightforward, general and process.
4. In the *Perfume: The Story of Murderer* novel published on February, 2007, the most frequent reverses appears to indicate movements in a general or literal direction.
5. In a similar movement, there is a component of meaning that distinguishes between the pairs of reverses that are found in the novel.
6. God creates everything in a pair, not only humans that have pair but also words. The word pair can be made by same meaning in opposite direction.

B. Suggestion

After analyzing and giving conclusions of the research of reverses in this last chapter, the writer would like to suggest the readers related to this paper:

For the student who studies linguistics, especially in semantic, it is important to understand the meaning of the word when studying a language and how a word has a relation with the other word. In this research the writer used a theory from Cruse (2010) and Rambaud (2012) as the main theory of reverses. So, for the next researcher about reverses, they can be combine with the other theory to make it more interesting.

For the lecturer especially lecturing in semantic field, the writer found that the material of semantics especially in reverses given by the lecturer was sufficient. The writer hopes this paper can be helpful for the lecturer to give some example to the student who has interest about this topic and enrich knowledge for them.

Then, the suggestion is for the people in general who have an interest in semantics field especially in reverses. This paper can be a reference in understanding the reverses theory and analysis.
