CHAPTER V

A. Conclusion

After analyzing 40 data of the types of Relative Clause to be sample of data analysis, the writer has inference based on references for composing this research. The writer found the differences between Restrictive and Non-Restrictive Clause, they are

- Relative Clauses have two different types; they are Restrictive Clause and Non-Restrictive Clause.
- 2. The differences between Restrictive Clause and Non-Restrictive Clause are the existence of comma. There is no comma in Restrictive Clause it means that the information about the noun is important to identify, while in Non-Restrictive Clause it has comma which means that it is just additional information. Then, the information about the noun in Restrictive Clause cannot be omitted from the sentence, while in Non-Restrictive Clause; the information about the noun can be omitted from the sentence since it is just additional information.
