CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclustion

In this chapter, the writer made conclusion from the data analysis and to answer questions of the research. The conclusion listed as follows:

- 1. Data indicates inflectional morphemes, the writer found 23 –ing inflectional suffix (signifies present participle tense), there are 20 –s inflectional suffix (signifies plural noun), there are 3 –ed inflectional suffix (signifies past tense), there are 2 –s inflectional suffix (signifies third person singular), there is 1 suffix –'s (marks possessive form of noun), and the rest of the suffixes such as –en, -er, and –est are not found in the album. These kinds of inflectional suffixes which indicate verb tenses, possessive form of noun, plural noun, third person singular. It shows from the calculation of the total 49 words, 26 words of verb tenses, 20 words of plural nouns, 2 words of simple present tense of third person singular, 1 word of possessive form,
- 2. Inflectional suffix that found often is the suffix –ing which indicates present participle, that found 23 words. Then the suffix –s which indicates plurality of noun, that found 20 words.

B. Suggestion

After analyzing the data and made conclusion for this research, the writer would like to give suggestions.

1. For students

The writer suggests the students to learn more about morphology as the basic of learning, as well as morphemes, free morpheme, bound morpheme, derivational morpheme, and inflectional morpheme. Learning the kinds of morphemes can help the students to recognize about morphemes and its functions, avoid mistakes in using or understanding the suffixes. This research can help them to understand better and obtain knowledge about inflectional morpheme.

2. For teacher

This research could also be useful for teachers, especially the ones who teach morphology. This research is advised for teacher's reference as their teaching material and to expand their teaching method, for example through song album.

3. For other researchers

The writer believes that this research could help other researchers who analyze inflectional morphemes. Therefore, the writer suggests researchers to do further research inflectional morphemes from another aspect.
