

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

#### A. Conclusion

In this chapter, the writer discusses about the correlation between chapter one and chapter four based on the theory in chapter two. This research is about illocutionary acts and the function of illocutionary acts that are found in the characters' utterance in *The Queen's Gambit* drama series. In this case, after doing analysis, there are some conclusion about the illocutionary acts that are used in the characters' utterance. The writer can conclude as follows:

1. Among five types, the writer has found four types of illocutionary acts in the characters' utterance in *The Queen's Gambit* from 56 data in the seven episodes. There are four types of illocutionary acts as classified by John Searle that are found in this study. They are *Representative* (15 data), *Directive* (23 data), *Expressive* (17 data), *Commissive* (1 data), and *Declare* (0 data).
2. In final analysis, the writer can conclude that the language study could not be completed without considering the aspect of speech situation. In this study, the writer examines the context as one of the speech situations. The writer interpreted all types of function on illocutionary act as classified by John Searle from the 56 data. There are *Convivial* (16 data), *Collaborative* (32 data), *Conflictual* (8 data), *Competitive* (0

*data*). The context is extremely influential in describing the situation in which illocutionary acts of utterance occur. The writer analyzes the context of the situation as a background knowledge to assume the function of each illocutionary acts.

## **B. Suggestion**

After analyzing and giving conclusion of the illocutionary act in the characters' utterance in *The Queen's Gambit* drama series. Finally, the scientific paper has come to the last paragraph. In this last chapter, the writer would like to suggest the readers related to this thesis.

1. For the students who study linguistics, especially in pragmatics, in this case illocutionary acts, they can take this thesis as a reference. They can know the type of illocutionary acts and also know how to identify the illocutionary acts.
2. For the other researchers, they can also take this research as a reference for further research in the case of illocutionary acts. They may combine and develop the research with many interdisciplinary studies.
