

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

This research focused in finding the data of word, phrase, clause of adjunct adverbial by determining the realization of adjunct adverbial in a novel **The Proposal**. It was aimed to find out the categories and the positions of adjunct adverbial. After analyzing all of them in a previous chapter, there are some conclusions that can be listed in following below:

1. There are 20 adjunct adverbials found in a novel **The Proposal** which are 1) *pretty loudly*, 2) *probably pretty*, 3) *really loudly*, 4) *so loudly*, 5) *so quickly*, 6) *definitely never*, 7) *very carefully*, 8) *too obviously*, 9) *almost always*, 10) *pretty quickly*, 11) *so gravely*, 12) *actually really*, 13) *ultimately very*, 14) *too often*, 15) *so thoughtfully*, 16) *too quickly*, 17) *probably sometime*, 18) *always so*, 19) *so tightly*, 20) *always too*.
2. As a result, there are exist the three categories from eight categories in combining with one-way dependency of head and modifier in adjunct adverbial namely Time Adjunct consists of 6 data, Manner Adjunct consists of 12 data, and Adjunct of Degree and Extent consists of 14 phrases.
3. After that, the result of positions of adjunct adverbial that occur in three position namely Initial Position consists of 2 data, Medial Position of

(M1) consists of 2 data, (M2) consists of 3 data, (M3) consists of 1 data, and End Position consists of 12 data.

4. The use of one-way dependency of a head and modifier is only found in one phrase namely an adverb phrase consists of 20 data.

B. Suggestion

Based on the conclusion that mentioned above, the writer has some suggestions to the readers as following items, which are:

1. To other writers, it is suggested to read comprehensively of adjunct adverbial, fully understanding to determine the category of adjunct adverbial properly and the application of the position in three positions in developing the research more completely comprehend, that might find different result.
2. To the readers, it is suggested that this research might be a further research relevance for who are interested in studying syntax especially in focusing on adjunct adverbial.
