

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

Through this research, the writer came to several conclusions:

1. Sam Witwicky as the main character in the *Transformers* film story is described as a person who has symptoms referring to mental and psychological disorders called Agitation. The agitation itself causes Sam as the main character who is often described as angry, anxious, and irritated. Sam's anger is mostly based on uncomfortable situations and considerable pressure for example when he scolded his parents for considering his privacy as a child was not respected. While the anxiety that Sam experienced was a spontaneous feeling due to pressure and was related to several crucial scenes in the film, behind his anxiety Sam was always able to cover up his anxiety with a small talk that he said, for example when he was nervous when he was with Mikaela and distracted feelings of anxiety with various spontaneous actions such as teasing. Furthermore, the annoyance that appears in Sam is mostly dominated by various actions and inappropriate behavior that Sam experienced in the previous scenes for example when he received harsh treatment from agent Simmons, besides that Sam's annoyance is a natural act considering that he himself is a temperament and easily offended.

2. The character of Sam Witwicky in Michael Bay's *Transformers* film shows that his every action is always influenced by personality aspects such as the *Id*, *Ego*, and *Superego*. The personality aspect of *Id* drives him to be stubborn, emotional, and lacks self-confidence, for example when Sam was so emotional that it was hard to find his grandfather's glasses. The personality aspect of *Ego* encourages him to be a brave and much more rational person in determining which actions are appropriate in an incident, for example when Sam suppressed his intentions and followed his ego not to fight with people he resented. While, the personality aspect of *Superego* encourages him to act and behave very closely with moral norms and values such as being a loving, caring, responsible, and willing to sacrifice person for example when Sam protected the AllSpark cube with all the risks involved, including his life.

B. Suggestion

1. **For the field of literary theory**

The writer hopes that with this thesis the scope of research with a literary psychology approach or psychoanalysis can be developed more broadly, in addition, it is hoped that this thesis can be used as reference material for further research.

2. **For society at large**

Research on the *Transformers* film by Michael Bay is still limited to the main character and his psychological condition which involves several aspects such as the *Id*, *Ego*, and *Superego*. Therefore,

it is recommended that further research be conducted that discusses the *Transformers* film by Michael Bay with a literary psychology approach about several other central characters besides Sam, such as Mikaela or from the Autobot parties. The number of discussions that can be further investigated in the *Transformers* film allows research to be carried out using other approaches such as the sociology of literature.
