

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND DISCUSSION

This chapter is divided into two sections. The first section is about the conclusion, and the second is about the suggestion. The conclusion is the Summary of Findings, which is based on the purpose of the study, research questions, and findings. The suggestion should be used to provide additional information about the data analysis and discussion.

A. Conclusion

According to the findings on the discussion of ellipsis in the song lyrics from 12 songs of “Natural Causes” song album by Skylar Grey, the researcher concludes that:

1. The elliptical items found in this research which are the nominal ellipsis consists of the word which functions as a pre-modifier, a head, and a post modifier in a noun group, while verbal ellipsis consists of lexical ellipsis and operator ellipsis, and clausal ellipsis consists of a clause within a modal and a prepositional.
2. The researcher discovered the use of ellipsis, including three types of ellipses: Nominal Ellipsis, Verbal Ellipsis, and Clausal Ellipsis.
3. From the analysis of ellipsis in the song lyrics of Natural Causes song album by Skylar Grey, these songs are dominated by the use of verbal ellipsis which has the percentage 54.06% of all.

B. Suggestion

Based on the preceding conclusion, the researcher makes the following suggestions:

1. To the students

The findings of this study will provide a better understanding of ellipsis analysis, which focuses on avoiding repetition and simplifying sentence form, as well as avoiding redundancy by omitting parts of words or phrases in sentences without reducing or changing the overall meaning. As a result, readers or song listeners are advised to use ellipsis in their speaking and writing activities.

2. To the reader

Ellipsis can assist in understanding a sentence in song lyrics. As a result, it is recommended that song listeners identify ellipsis elements such as nominal ellipsis, verbal ellipsis, clausal ellipsis, and their functions in sentences.

3. To the writer

Ellipsis research can be obtained from various data sources. In general, novels are the most widely used research sources. This thesis proves that not only novels, song lyrics can also be a source of research data, and besides that there are also many other sources of research data.
