CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

The conclusions are described based on the author's questions in the first chapter, while the suggestions are intended to provide information to further researchers who are interested in analyzing the data using the same theory. The data analysis revealed that lexical ambiguity is defined as a situation in which a word has more than one meaning. Then, in this structural ambiguity, sentences with different interpretations in a given context occur. In order to create this categorize, Hurford and Heasley's theory of lexical and structural ambiguity was used. The following is the conclusion:

1. The writer analyzed 25 data of lexical and structural ambiguity that were used in the movie. The analysis's study findings were; the types of ambiguity appears in lexical ambiguity that are categorizes into polysemy and homonymy with 15 data more often than in the structural ambiguity with 10 data.
2. The writer analyzed 25 data the causal factor of ambiguity that were used in the movie. The analysis's study findings 15 data of lexical ambiguity were categorizes into polysemy and homonymy and then 11 data of structural ambiguity were categorizes into grammatical forms, equivocal phrase, and contextual ambiguity.
