## **CHAPTER V**

## **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

In this chapter, the researcher explains about the conclusion and suggestion for the reader to comprehend more about the research.

## A. Conclusion

The researcher has been particularly concerned at the English monophthong in Day6 song. To sum up this chapter in the three songs, the researcher can conclude that:

- 1. All of this English monophthong, the researcher found 9 English monophthong. 30 data was taken from 3 songs from a Sunrise album by Day6. The first song produced a total of 17 data with percentage 54,8%. The second song produced a total of 7 data with percentage 23,3%. In addition, the third song produced a total of 6 data with percentage 20%. In these data, 9 types of monophthong were found, namely long monophthong, and the other name is short monophthong, as the monophthong because air escapes from the mouth.
- 2. Monophthong means one sound or single sound. Monophthong form is a special subject. It is said to be special because elements are formed from special phonemes. Not all phonemes can produce diphthong. Not all vowel phonemes can form a monophthong. The last conclusion in this chapter, letters are concrete, phoneme is abstract. As shown in the example of word /see/ but the

sound heard is si. Phoneme abstract which shows what letters are written and what sounds are heard.

## **B.** Suggestion

After finding and explaining how monophthong has made in Day6's songs, the researcher has some suggestion to the readers related to the paper.

- 1. For the readers. It is suggestion that the students of English department should also read it, in order to get knowledge and to board their perception. The researcher should not only know the vocabulary, it also has to know the phoneme and vowel that make up monophthong.
