CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

Feminism aims for women to have their own freedom to live their life to the fullest. Feminism concerned all aspects of women's lives. The existence of the feminism movement, which began hundreds of years ago, made feminists know the capacities and abilities they could develop freely without patriarchal pressure. After analyzing the previous chapter, the writer concluded that data was taken from Notes to Self-Novel by Emilie Pine in 2018. Based on the data analysis, the writer found the answer to two problems formulated in the first chapter as follows:

1. Notes to Self is a non-fiction novel which tells a fantastic story about a woman's struggle to find out what she wants to become. The writer found 8 types of feminism in Notes to Self-novel 2018 by Emilie Pine that had been proposed by Tong, namely liberal feminism, radical feminism, Marxist feminism, psychoanalytic feminism, care-focused feminism, multicultural, global, and postcolonial feminism, ecofeminism, and postmodern and third wave feminism. Based on data analysis, the writer found 28 data of feminism. The most dominant data is liberal feminism which with percentage 28.6 %, radical feminism with percentage 10,7 %, Marxist feminism with percentage 10.7 %, psychoanalytic feminism with percentage 14.3 %, care-focused feminism with percentage 14.3 %, multicultural, global,

and postcolonial feminism with percentage 10.7 %, postmodern and third wave feminism with percentage 7.1 %, and the list amount is ecofeminism with percentage 3.6 %.

2. The reflection of all feminism types in Notes to Self-novel is reflected in the main character Emilie. Started with the independent Emilie, she is shown through how she faces problems and solves them on their own without relying on others. Her courage and decisiveness in expressing her opinion in her work environment, critical of the problems that arise and responsible to herself. In addition, Emilie also showed her empathy and concern for fellow women who have experienced violence and encouraged them to dare to voice their rights. It was demonstrated when she was a lecturer and speaker in voicing feminist rights.

B. Suggestion

After analyzing this research completely, the writer would present some suggestion based on the result of the research which have been obtained as follows:

1. For the researchers
 - a. The writer suggests the other researchers who want to conduct similar research about feminism literary criticism to use the data in this study as a reference.

2. For the readers
 - a. Readers should learn about the feminism to broaden their knowledge particularly the types of feminism.
 - b. The writer suggests the readers to relate the feminism characteristic found in this study to be developed in real life.
