CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

Based on the research that has been done which is taken from Al Jazeera News. And this discussion raised 11 important articles from Al Jazeera News that was taken from selected articles, this can be concluded that: 1. In this study, it can be proven that the participle phrase can occur if the

- participle form meets noun phrase and prepositional phrase
- 2. Based on its usage, there are structural similarities between participle phrases and gerund phrases. However, gerund phrases are useful as nouns. Meanwhile, the participle phrase is useful as an adjective or adverb in a sentence, for example: A tray containing some donuts, ringing in Berlin and We found 6 of them hiding in a cellar.
- 3. Basically, participle phrases have two forms, namely past form and present form. Present form has the characteristics of words that have the suffix "-ing". Meanwhile, the past form has the suffix "-ed".
- 4. The format of the position of the participle phrase in a sentence, both simple sentence, compound sentence, complex sentence and compound complex sentence is in front or behind the sentence.
- 5. The form of the participle phrase does not depend on any particle, both present particle (is, am or are), past particle (was or were) or perfect participle (has been, have been or had been).

- 6. After conducting research on participle phrases in Al Jazeera News from October 2020 to January 2021, 16 participle phrases have been found which are divided into two types, namely past form and present form.
- From research conducted in Al Jazeera News from October 2020 to January 2021, there is a participle form that has a present form of 10 phrases. This if the percentage becomes 68.75%.
- 8. From research conducted in Al Jazeera News from October 2020 to January 2021, there is a participle form that has a past form of 6 phrases. This if the percentage becomes 31.25%.
- Finally, the participle phrase always explains the clause or phrase after or before. And the participle phrase is also always related to the clause or phrase after or before.

B. Suggestion

Based on the research that has been done, the researchers suggest for college and pre students who are studying Linguistics, especially syntax and this is focused on participle phrases. Researchers suggest, as follows:

1. For Campus

The author hopes that this research can help students as a reference for research on campus and it can also add reading sources from the library. So that students are easy to find sources of reference in research.

2. For Students

The researcher hopes that this research can help students to understand the substance of linguistics, namely syntax which focuses on participle phrases. Moreover, from this research, the writer hopes that in the next generation, this research can be developed again so that the research of this participle phrase is always updated.
