CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

This chapter presents the conclusions of the research based on the analysis and discussion in the previous chapter including a brief explanation of the devoiced consonant data and which devoiced consonant appears most dominantly in the lyrics:

- The writer draws the conclusion that there is analysis data gathered from 2 albums by Ariana Grande, those both albums are "My Everything" possesses 11 songs as the first album and "Dangerous Woman" album possesses 1 song, the writer concentrated on the devoiced consonants /r/, /y/, and /w/.
- 2. The analysis indicates that eleven songs from the album "*My Everything*" contain 29 devoiced forms of the consonants /r/, /y/, and /w/ and from Album "*Dangerous Woman*" contain 3 devoiced forms of the consonants /r/, /y/, and /w/.
- 3. The writer discovered that there were 32 data of devoiced consonants as the most with percentage of 87% for /r/, 1 data of devoiced consonants with percentage of 3% for /y/, and 3 data of devoiced consonants as the least with percentage of 10% for /w/.

B. Suggestion

At the conclusion of the research, the writer would like to provide the following suggestions based on the findings:

- 1. The writers recommend that teachers or lecturers utilize the findings of this study as a reference. The teacher or lecturers should utilize basic lyrics when imparting material through song lyrics so that they are easy to learn and retain.
- 2. This study is about the devoiced consonants in Ariana Grande's song lyrics for future researchers. As a result, this research can be used as a reference to provide understanding to the same topic.
- 3. The writer hopes that by reading the findings of this study, readers, particularly students, may gain a better understanding of devoiced consonants.
