

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

The two main sections of this chapter are conclusions and suggestions. The first section contains the summary or points of the findings and discussion regarding the formulation of the problem and the objectives of the research. The second section contains suggestions intended for the academic community and other researchers, readers, and other researchers.

#### A. Conclusion

The conclusion of the research in addressing the research questions related to the kind of linguistic form of men and women language and linguistic behaviors of men and women in *Your Place or Mine* Movie on Netflix are as follows:

1. The data are taken from *Your Place or Mine* Movie (2023) on Netflix, which lasted for 2 hours and consisted of 13 data of linguistic forms and differences in linguistic behaviors of men and women. The object data total consist of 55, there are taken from *Your Place or Mine* Movie (2023) by Aline Brosh McKenna and this movie lasted for 2 hours.
2. The writer found 4 types of linguistic forms from men's language which are minimal response (21%), command and directive (21%), topic choice (11%), and swearing words (21%) men also use women 's linguistic form which are Tag question (16%), lexical hedges (5%), and avoiding of strong swear words (5%)

3. The writer found 9 types of linguistic forms from women's language which are tag questions (14%), lexical hedges, or fillers (22%), raising intonation on declarative (6%), avoidance of strong swear words (22%), super polite' forms (3%), emphatic stress (8%), hypercorrect grammar(6%), intensifier (11%) and empty' adjectives (8%).
4. The differences in linguistic behavior.

Research reveals that women use interrogative forms more frequently than men, making them more dominant in conversations. Men view conversations as a way to establish dominance in relationships, while women view them as a way to create intimate bonds with men. Topic choice varies, with men discussing impersonal topics like hobbies, while women focus on personal matters. Tones also vary, with women using emphatic stress and raising intonation in declarative sentences to emphasize their points.
