

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGESTION

a. Conclusion

Based on the research findings and discussion, some conclusions be formulated as follows.

1. Concerning the objective of the study which is classifying types of offensive language in the Dota 2 online game, 7 out of 10 types of offensive language are found which are *Cursing, Profanity, Obscenity, Vulgarity, Slang, Epithets, Insult and slurs*.
2. Regarding the second objective which is the most frequent offensive language used by gamers in Dota 2 online games. The writer found offensive language types of Insults and slurs are dominant in this research. Insults and slurs are found 14 times out of 30 representative data. Meanwhile, 3 other types that are not found are Blasphemy, Taboo, and Scatology.

B. Suggestions

Based on the results of the research which have been obtained, some suggestions are stated for further research. This suggestion is presented as follows:

1. To Student of English Language and other Researchers

- a. Student and researcher should understand the kinds of methodology research.
- b. The student and researcher should understand about the different between qualitative and quantitative research.
- c. The use of offensive language is an interesting topic to be analyzed. The writer suggested to the next researcher to develop this research in a wider context such as social context of the general public.

2. To the Readers

- a. The readers should understand about sociolinguistics
- b. This study is relatable in daily life of gaming community. The writer hopes to read this research in order to avoid the use of offensive language in everyday life and understand the meaning of them. There are still many words that are more appropriate to use when you are feeling emotional because it does not always mean that the speaker want to hurt other people's feelings through the use of offensive language.

3. To the Literature Department and the Campus

- a. Lecture should know and understand the student's research as a reference and inform about the research to the new student.
- b. The writer expected that this paper can be useful for students and readers in terms of analyzing works of sociolinguistics about the types of offensive language.
