CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

Based on the data analysis performed in the previous chapter, this chapter will provide conclusions in answering research questions. Furthermore, the writer makes recommendations for numerous parties, which will be discussed in turn below.

A. Conclusion

This research aims to describe the etymology of the word and identify the categories of swearing words, after which the cause for swearing is explained by the SPEAKING term used by the characters. Several conclusions are drawn by the writer as a result of this investigation, including:

1. The categories of swear words are divided into 6 categories. There are 12 data analysed to identify the category of swear words by also looking at the etymology of each word. The number of swear words in the Euphoria is 666 data. The Sexual Activities Theme is the most prevalent of swear words in Euphoria script with a total of data is 441, and the percentage is 66,21%, then the second is The Scatological Theme with a total of 138 data with a percentage of 20,72%, then the third is Minor Theme with a total of 44 data with a percentage of 6,60%, then the fourth is The Sex Organ Theme with a total of 23 data with a percentage of 3,45%, then the fifth is The Mother Theme with a

total of 16 data with a percentage of 2,40%. The last one is The Religious Theme which only appears on 4 data with a percentage of 0,60%.

2. Referring to 12 data analysed, the most common reason that characters use after uttering swear words is To Mock Authority, with a total of data is 7, and the percentage is 58,33%, then the second is To Draw Attention with a total of 3 data with a percentage of 25%, and the reason To Show Contempt & To Provoke have the same total of 1 data with a percentage 8,33%.

B. Suggestion

The writer has some suggestions for several parties based on this research. The writer recognizes that this research is not perfect, but the writer hopes that this research can help future researchers who want to conduct similar research. Firstly, for students, investigating and discovering politeness and impoliteness in daily life to be more aware and communicate without using swear words. Furthermore, it is suggested to better understand the use of swearing words and provide understanding of the language.

Secondly, for the sociolinguistics field, developing the reasons for swearing with supporting analysis such as SPEAKING term is recommended to strengthen the argument of what things cause someone to say swear words in a dialog or writing. This study indicates that future researchers investigate swear words from various types of literature or films. It serves as a resource for those interested in the relationship between swear words and society.

Lastly, for general readers who have no expertise of Linguistics, particularly Sociolinguistics, this study might help readers to enrich their knowledge and understand the swear words used in movies in general. They may understand English jokes if they contain swear words. Readers may gain a new vocabulary of swear words they have never heard before. As a result, they should avoid using it when conversing with foreigners to avoid misunderstandings.
